Quite often, those that become residents have an assumption that they will age alone, with occasional visits from family. In addition, we've seen that older adults have fallen victim to the adverse effects of the COVID-19 pandemic, which has hindered many social experiences. According to a study by the National Poll on Again, in June 2020, about half of adults age 50 to 80 reported feeling isolated from others, compared to their feelings before the pandemic.

The value of socialization in senior care centers is truly immeasurable. Among the benefits of living with others is the support that residents receive from each other. Our residents are also exposed to many aspects of their lives that they experiences before senior living. They can find fulfillment every day through companionship and participation in social events and stimulating activities. Whether it is through their knitting group, or visits from the local aquarium, residents of our senior care facilities are never bored – if they so choose. Diversity and inclusion of all interests allows the residents to either try new things or enjoy hobbies they have always loved. It is important that our resident understand that it is ultimately up to them, but having a fulfilled life at all phases of development is what we aim to achieve.

With a small number of residents living at Mere Point, and Nursing at Memory Care at The Garden, our team members are able to learn each resident's unique personal characteristics so they may customize programs and offer meaningful opportunities to each resident. Additionally, The Garden offers architecture and interior decor with soothing design elements that are helpful to individuals with memory loss, quiet and comfortable gathering areas for meaningful family visits, inviting common spaces that encourage enjoyable social interactions, professionally maintained outdoor garden and patios, and campus nature and walking trails.

> > It is imperative that memory care residents have opportunities to experience stimulating activities that can ease their condition. Activities like gentle exercise and movement programs, recollection groups, crafting, food tastings, and music programs can strongly help those with memory loss. On the other side of the senior care experience are the caregivers, who also need to care for themselves. Caregiving for a loved one is likely to bring out many different emotions, both positive and negative. Feeling frustrated is a common experience, and taking care of oneself is one of the most important things a caregiver can do. It is important to get time to oneself, eat healthy foods, and apply some type of active activity to daily routines.

> > Our Respite Care Program offers a short- to longterm respite stay options in order to provide relief to caregivers. The program offers stays as short as one week, as long as a month, or even open-ended.
